3 Million Meals and counting!

Meals on Wheels is on track to deliver its **three millionth meal** this fall! Current projections will have us reach that milestone in mid-October.

Three million of anything is a lot, and 3 million meals is quite an impressive number. The box to the right offers several examples to help visualize what 3 million meals look like.

But we know it's really not about how high they will stack or how far they will stretch.

- It's about the millions of smiles, hugs, laughs and conversations at all those deliveries.
- It's really about the thousands of lives that were positively impacted by those meals, the neighbors who were able to remain longer in the home they loved because they received a hot, healthy lunch each day.
- It's about fighting the isolation that comes with being homebound, forming relationships that span months and years.

Three million meals have made this community healthier, safer, stronger, and more connected because thousands of volunteers have taken the time to care, one meal, one day, one knock at a time.

Mourishing the Need

I continue to be grateful for the love and generosity shown by this community! Our donors and volunteers are truly the most generous and loving people we know. With your support, Meals on Wheels is able to **nourish the needs** of our vulnerable homebound population.

In addition, by not accepting government funding, Meals on Wheels remains at liberty to serve all ages and all incomes. Currently, 18% of those we serve are **under** the age of 60 - and no one else serves this population. If not for Meals on Wheels, these individuals would have nowhere to turn for **nourishment**.



Emma* put a face on this statistic when she called earlier this year. When Emma was in her early 50s, she was diagnosed with cancer. Additionally, complications from surgery hindered her recovery. This business graduate from the University of Virginia lost both her job and home due to the severity and longevity of that illness.

Now at age 58, she lives alone in a local apartment. When she was diagnosed with a different and more aggressive cancer earlier this year, she truly was at her wits' end. Our program staff told her that Meals on Wheels would deliver, beginning immediately, and her response was overwhelmed relief. Emma's tearful call of appreciation after receiving her first meal touched our entire office.

And we were delighted just a few weeks ago to receive an enthusiastic call from Robert* - "I just got my lab results back, and my A1C is down to 6.9! It hasn't been that good in years. I am sure it's because since I started getting Meals on Wheels, I'm eating better. Thank you so much!"

Nourishment can take on many different 'looks'. It definitely looks like a hot, healthy meal that's delivered with a knock on the door and a friendly chat in the doorway. It looks like improved lab results due to a consistently healthier diet. It can also look like a Birthday Box delivered with a special serenade, or supplemental pet food for a furry friend. More recently, it looks like a longer weekly visit from a Friendly Visitor who has been trained and matched for compatibility. Or it may look like hope, when you thought there weren't any other options.

Thank you for supporting Meals on Wheels, so that we, in turn, can nourish the many needs in our community!



The Power of a Knock

The 70 black angus cows that once roamed William and Marie Caldwell's sprawling Bedford County farm are gone, the kids are grown, and visitors are a rarity for the couple, now in their 80's. "That's the hardest thing for me about getting older," said Marie who has lived on the farm with William for almost 40 years. "I miss the children and the animals."

Then one day Tucker, a 12-year-old King Charles Springer mix, walked by with his owners George and Kathy Kolar. Smitten, Marie promptly ordered dog treats and put a water bowl outside just in case Tucker and the Kolars came back.

Four months later, the Caldwells not only get to see Tucker regularly, but they also have visitors daily thanks to George Kolar, a volunteer with Meals on Wheels of Greater Lynchburg.

After the two families got to know one another, the Kolars suggested the Caldwells sign up for Meals on Wheels. Each of the Caldwells are facing significant health challenges not uncommon to their age, neither drive anymore, and they have

hired someone to do their grocery shopping and laundry.

Even though cooking was increasingly a challenge, Marie was still hesitant and put off calling Meals on Wheels. She was afraid she would be taking food away from someone else who really needed it.

"I don't like to ask people for help," Marie said. But Kathy Kolar kept asking.

Marie finally gave in after learning that the service was created specifically to help those who can't prepare their own meals and it was affordable. "It's the best thing that's happened to me in a long time," said Marie. "It's been really nice to have something homecooked."

"Some days it was hard to just get up and get dressed," said Marie. "Now we have something to look forward to. All the people who bring the meals are wonderful. I always tell them how much I appreciate it."

George said many of the people he delivers meals to are older and they are the reason he enjoys his volunteer work so much.

He has no problem pulling clients into conversations and checking to make sure they are cool during the summer and warm in the winter. He doesn't deny surreptitiously looking around for other ways he might be able to help them. George will often see a need he can meet through his other volunteer work with hospice and veteran's organizations.

"I've grown to love all the people I meet," George said. He now drives three routes, often adding special touches to deliveries like his daughter's homemade jams or holiday treats.

"We were brought up in the 50s. Neighbors used to help neighbors and people used to help people. That's the way we were brought up. I thoroughly enjoy doing what I do."



Remembering Scott

In June we were heart-broken to lose a close friend and Board Member with the passing of Scott Robert.

Scott joined the Meals on Wheels Board in 2020 and brought his valuable professional skills as well as his vibrant personality and energy to benefit our organization. He helped us navigate through the pandemic, served as co-chair of the Public Relations Committee, and on the annual golf tournament planning committee.

Scott was an accomplished musician, a natural athlete, active in his church, and a beloved professor at University of Lynchburg. Our love and condolences go out to his wife Laura and their three children, Virginia, Sarah, and Joseph.




